Further Instructions:

1. The body of the paper should not exceed 3,500 words (excluding Abstract, References, and Figures/Tables).
2. Submitting your paper:
 - a. Register and submit your paper via Editorial Manager (www.editorialmanager.com/wounds).
 - b. Title field of Editorial Manager: Following your paper’s title, include “CONTEST ENTRY” at the end, such as: “Evaluating the Effects of Managing Lower Extremity Wounds With NPWTi-d -- CONTEST ENTRY”
3. Peer review:
 - a. All papers/manuscripts must be blinded for review.
 - i. Do not include author names, affiliations, etc.
 - b. Unblinded papers will be returned to the corresponding author to be corrected.
4. Figures/Tables:
 - a. Include all accompanying Figures and Tables with a legend.
 - b. Make reference to all Figures/Tables within the body of the paper.
